Digital Leap Initiative

NSBA is joining with AASA and the Consortium for School Networking (CoSN) in strengthening the skills of school leaders to transform student learning through technology. A detailed campaign strategy is being developed to inform superintendents, school boards and chief technology officers about the efforts of the three national associations to support digital conversion. In NSBA's case, for instance, we will be highlighting the work of our Technology Leadership Network and the school site visits. The initiative will be launched by October.

- Implement workable processes
- Leverage procurement
- Provide training
- Inform parents
- Make security a priority
- Review and adjust

Security Questions to Ask of an Online Service Provider

In the fall, CoSN will expand the existing privacy toolkit that we launched in March with additional sections covering the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA) and the Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) – filling out the privacy guide with all four federal privacy laws applied to K-12 education.

Curt Cearley has been asked to review the <u>Connections For Classroom</u> <u>grants</u> for the Governor's Office of Student Achievement. He has learned that thus far, *only 60 of the 180 eligible districts* have applied. The deadline is **August 29**, so interested districts are reminded that the money is available, and the application is a bit complex, so it can't be completed in a day or two.
